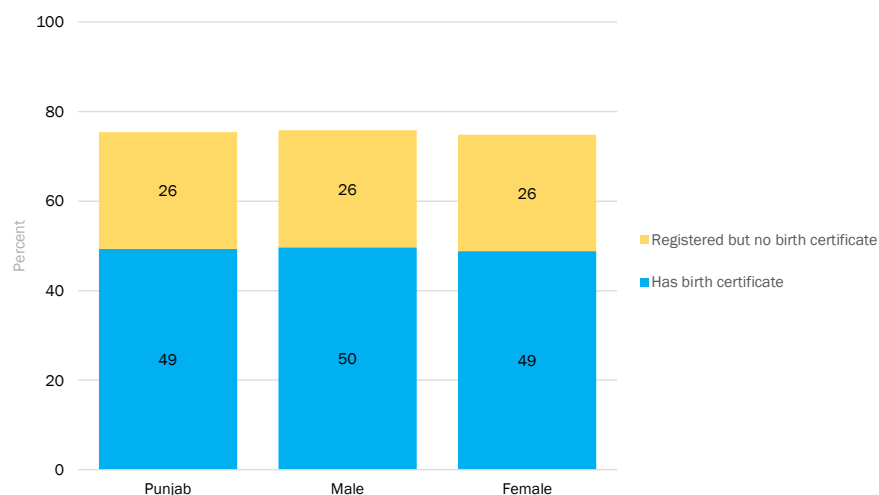




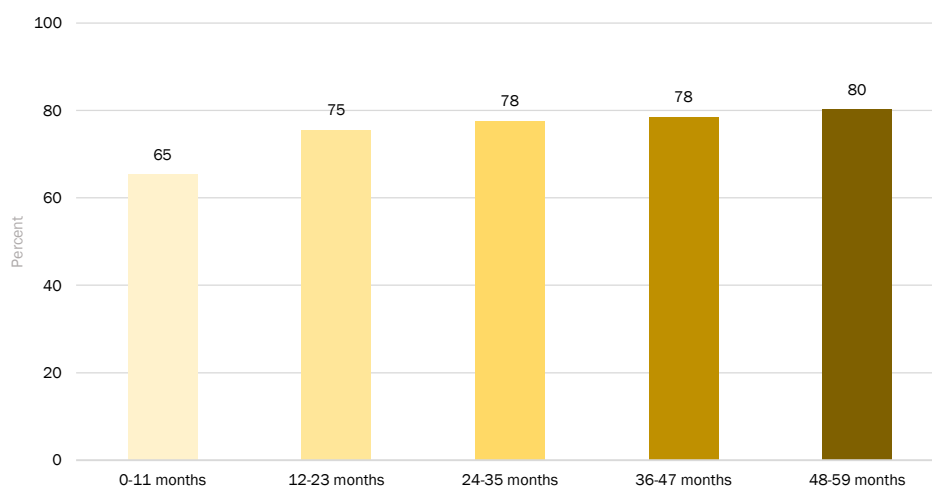
Birth Registration Levels

Birth registration for Children Under-Five: SDG 16.9.1

Key Messages

- Three out of four (75%) children under-five registered with civil authorities.
- 50% of children have birth certificates in their households.
- Every third child of less than one year is not registered with civil authorities.
- Birth registration among the richest is 92% compared to 49% among the poorest.
- Only 61% of children whose mothers have no education are registered compared to 91% whose mothers have higher education.
- Birth registration is highest in Gujranwala division (93.7%) and lowest in D.G. Khan (38.2%).
- Three out of 5 mothers do not know how to register a birth with civil authorities.

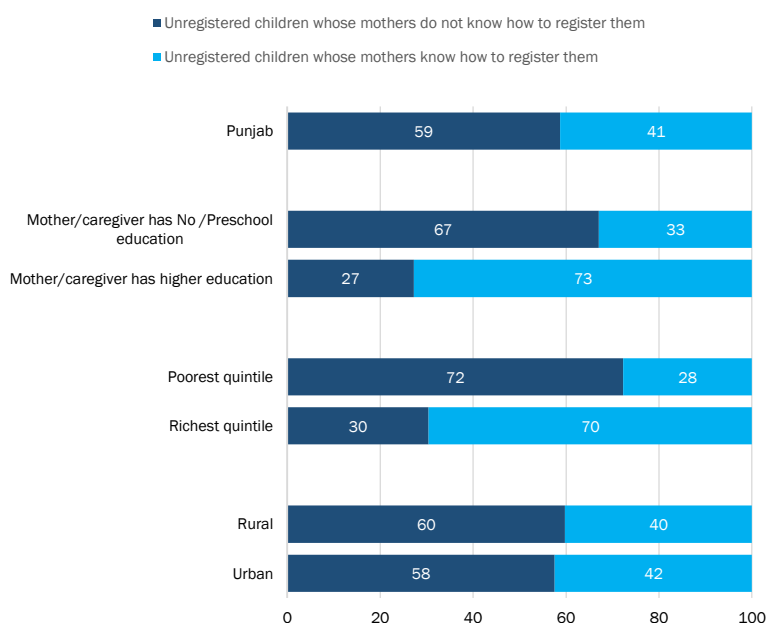
